

**Application Deadlines (these are priority deadlines only; applications will continue to be accepted until the program is full):**

**Waterloo Campus**

Full-time: January 30 (applicants on a study permit); May 1 (all other applicants)

Part-time: May 1

**Toronto Campus**

Part-time Weekends (MBA, MBA/CMA, MBA/CFA): February 1.

Laurier has a rolling admissions process for all MBA programs. Applicants are encouraged to apply early. For more information, contact Maureen Ferraro at [mferraro@wlu.ca](mailto:mferraro@wlu.ca).

**An application for admission to the MBA program must include:**

- a completed application form;
- a completed Personal Information Form - MBA;
- a résumé of your academic and work experience; your resume should account for all periods of time; note if work is full or part-time and whether it is managerial;
- official transcripts and degree certificates (where applicable) of all undergraduate and graduate work (more information on transcripts); applicants presenting international credentials must provide literal translations and an official credential assessment (more information);
- completed reference forms; 3 references are required, at least one reference must be academic and one must be professional; if you have not completed a university course in the last five years, all three of your references may be professional (more information);
- evidence of quantitative skills is required for admission to the MBA program; normally this is demonstrated by a minimum score of 550 on the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT); the GMAT requirement may be waived with evidence of quantitative skills normally shown by successful completion of a current (within the last five years) university-level course in calculus or statistics with a grade of B (73%) or better (only considered if all other admission requirements are met or exceeded); GMAT is recommended to strengthen an application; GMAT is mandatory for all international applicants;
- for international applicants, an official statement of your acceptable English-language test results (more information);
- if you are a Permanent Resident, evidence of your status in Canada is required; you must provide a photocopy of your signed "Record of Landing" or photocopies of both sides of your Permanent Resident card.
