## BALSILLIE DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS

Jim Balsillie, Co-CEO of Research in Motion, has donated funds to create at least twelve new research fellowships for Wilfrid Laurier University graduate students. The fellowships will be awarded annually to graduate students in programs attached to the Balsillie School of International Affairs and who satisfy the eligibility requirements for graduate scholarship. The recipients of the Balsillie Doctoral Fellowship, valued at \$25,000 per year, will be expected to involve themselves in research and policy-oriented CIGI events pertaining to their work. Selection will be made by the appropriate program directors in consultation with CIGI representatives and the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

**Fellowships for entering students:** Students admitted to the PhD program in global governance at Wilfrid Laurier University will typically receive a Balsillie Fellowship for their first year of study upon receipt of this application (to be submitted with the application for admission).

**Renewed Fellowship for continuing students:** Balsillie Doctoral Fellowships are not automatically renewable. Students who wish to apply for a renewal are required to submit this application, a curriculum vita which includes evidence of academic accomplishments (e.g., publications, presentations at conferences, other scholarly work) and summarizes employment experience related to the field of global governance. For an application to renew a Balsillie Doctoral Fellowship, at least one, but no more than two letters of support from academic CIGI representatives who can comment on your involvement in the activities of CIGI is required. To be eligible for a renewal of the Balsillie Doctoral Fellowship, a student also must have submitted, by June 1 annually, a satisfactory PhD progress report. The completed application and all supporting documents are to be submitted to the Office of Graduate Studies by June 1 annually.
