

## International Baccalaureate (IB) Transfer Credit

Note: Transfer credits will be considered for all higher level courses completed with a minimum score of 5, for both diploma and certificate applicants, subject to applicability to the program offered. Applicants with a minimum of B in each TOK and EE will receive 1.0 junior transfer credit – i.e., 0.5 Jr. PP + 0.5 Jr. Div x (relative to topic covered in Extended Essay). A maximum of 3.0 transfer credit may be awarded.

Applicants completing individual IB courses in conjunction with another educational system will be assessed on the basis of their entire academic record.
