



BI499 – Thesis (1.5 Credits)

- Description:
 - Individually supervised research resulting in the presentation of a thesis. Students taking this course are required to attend all departmental seminars. Throughout the course organizational meetings will occur following the departmental seminar
- Requirements:
 - Prior completion of 15.0 credits in any Honours Biology program
 - either BI296 or CH390
 - minimum GPA of 7.0 in biology
- Registration (Forms are available from the Biology Department website):
 - Students must apply for the course in the winter term prior to Year 4 indicating which faculty member(s) you wish to serve as your supervisor (prior discussion with a faculty member to discuss research options is highly advised).
 - Applications must be accompanied by a “Letter of Motivation” outlining why you wish to pursue a thesis (500 words or less)
 - Deadline for submission of these documents is Feb 28, 2012
 - Notification of acceptance will be provide in March, 2012
