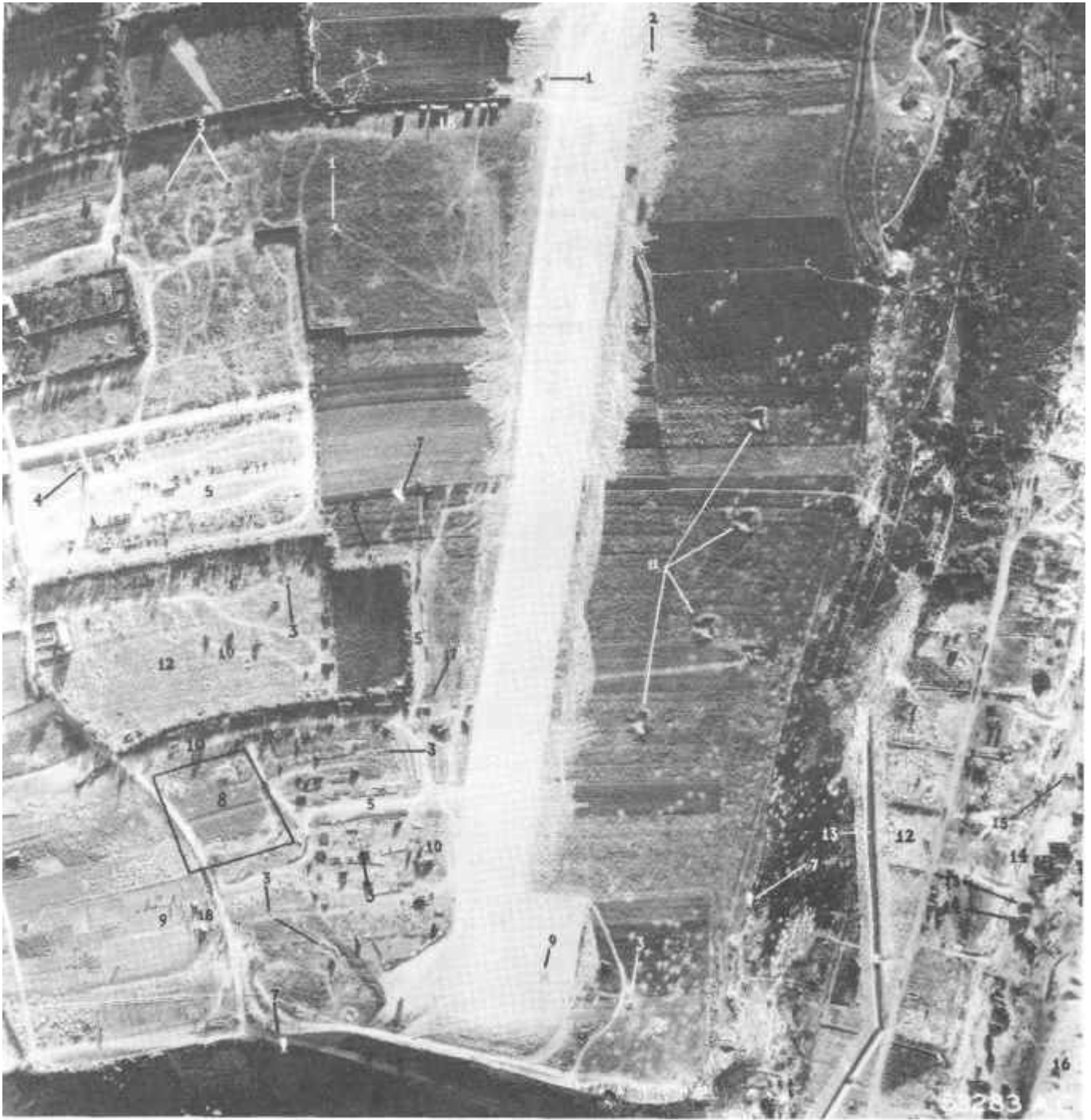
Name the Airfield!
