

Celebrate with us at Laurier's spring convocation 2015

- Waterloo convocation runs between June 8 and 12.
- Brantford convocation runs between Jun 16 and 17.
- There are 3,004 students qualified to graduate.
- 2,731 students will receive undergraduate degrees.
- 265 will receive graduate degrees.
- 8 will receive diplomas.
- There are 12 ceremonies: 9 will be in Waterloo, 3 will be in Brantford.
- There are 9 faculties at Laurier, including:
 - Arts
 - Business and Economics
 - Education
 - Music
 - Science
 - Social Work
 - Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies
 - Human and Social Sciences
 - Liberal Arts
- There are a total of 321 volunteers helping at convocation: 285 at Laurier's Waterloo campus, 36 at Laurier's Brantford campus.
- Over 9,100 guests are expected to attend Laurier's convocation: 7,000 at Laurier's Waterloo convocation, 2,100 at Laurier's Brantford convocation.

- Laurier is awarding its 284th honorary degree since 1961, with the 2015 being: opera singer Isabel Bayrakdarian, scholar Natalie Zemon Davis, education activist Ziauddin Yousafzai, entrepreneur Aziz Bhaloo, Lutheran leader Martin Junge, Mohawk language preservationist Brian Maracle, and the co-creator of the Deglassi television series Linda Schuyler.
- Laurier has over 89,000 alumni in over 100 countries around the world.
- This will be Laurier's 122nd official convocation ceremony since 1961.
